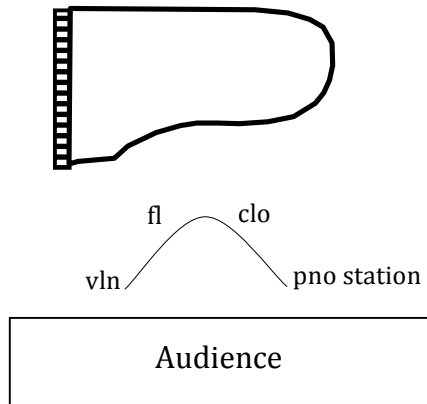
Notes:

All marked time is referential. The performance should be tight yet musical. Avoid using stopwatch or other time-keeping devices. The movements proceed without stopping.

If necessary, amplify all instruments.

Grand piano is needed for the performance of *Adventures of an Annihilated Mirror*. If possible: remove the grand piano's lid.

General Set Up:



Individual Movements:

1. *Thousand Years*. (ca. 2')
2. *Over and Above. A Meditative Choral*. (ca. 1'40")
3. *Widen the Place*. (ca. 30")
4. *Exaltation. Perpetuum Mobile*. (ca. 3')
5. *An Abyss*. (ca. 40")
6. *Illumined*. (ca. 1'30")
7. *Within Herself*. (ca. 1'30")

Notes to some movements:

2. *Over and Above. A Meditative Choral*

Each performer: recollect five experiences in which the following qualities presented themselves individually. Describe the experiences verbally to yourself. Think of five vocal sounds that may evoke the experiences. Write the sounds directly into your score. In the performance, revive these experiences through the assigned sounds.

Full black cell with white numbers: produce sound for assigned duration

Full white cell with black numbers: produce silence for assigned duration

4. *Exaltation. Perpetuum Mobile*

Each player selects a performance action and place of contact with the piano for each hand. You may choose an action from the following list or create your own. No players should perform the same combination of actions.

Suggested actions: kick, hit, pluck strum, knock, bow.

Suggested placements (avoid the keyboard): strings, sting pegs, case, metal dividers, key lid, board, legs, chair.

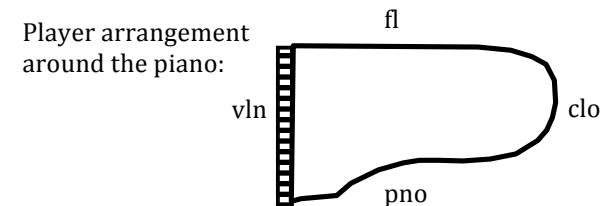

FR: flutist right hand

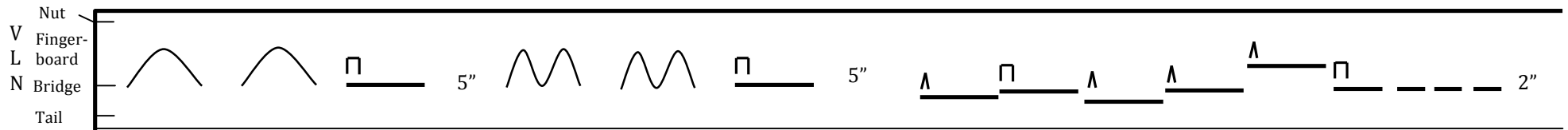

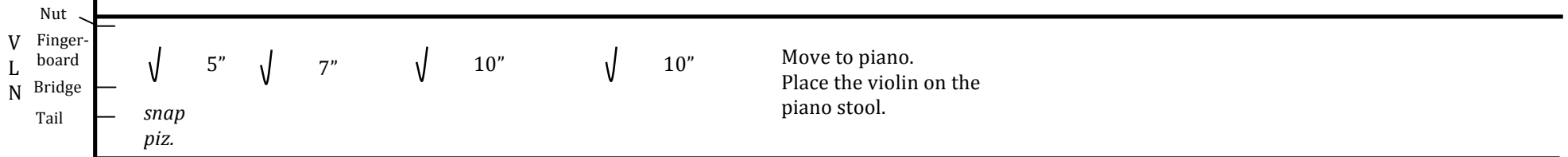
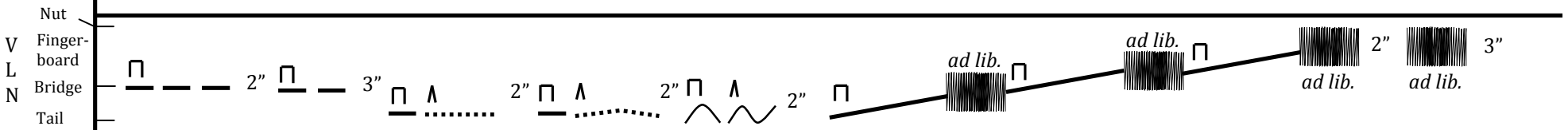
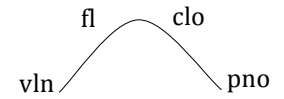


Scordatura: A, D#, G#, E

Bow on any or all strings.

Place the non-laying hand behind the back.

While violin performs the music, the rest of the ensemble silently imitates the violinist's movements in perfect synchrony. Ensemble set up:

5. *An Abyss.* (ca. 1'30")



Perform on the keys and pedals *ad lib.* material in assigned registers.
 Key registers: low, medium, high.
 Pedals (with accents): damper (D), *una corda* (U)

Hit *ad lib.* strings with both hands in the registers where piano performs. Keep muted until next hit.

7. *Within Herself*. (1'30")

Perform the segment 9 times (each iteration is 10 seconds long), while consulting the map below. The map shows the balance between sound and silent action performed in the air. Allow for nuances and transitions between sound and silence.

Perform on the closed lid.
Damper pedal down throughout.
Percussive.

After 9 repetitions, the whole ensemble stops and freezes for 10" which completes the composition.
